Directions:

- 1. Fill out form completely and legibly. Be specific as to what part you are protesting or what action are you appealing or requesting.
- 2. Once you have the form filled out, take it to registration and have them sign it and pay the fees (if any).
- 3. Once signed by registration, the form must be presented to the Race Director within 30 (thirty) minutes of the finish of the race.
- 4. For mechanical protests a bond will be set and must be put up before any teardown begins.
- 5. Mechanical protests require a \$100 fee payable to registration. Appeals require a \$25 fee payable to registration. Requests for action require a \$25 fee payable to registration which is refundable if the action is upheld.
